

Protect Your Property Rights

Provisions of Corinna's proposed new ordinance could result in a major forced intrusion on private property.

The development of any transmission line between 69kV and 115kV would require us to survey all private property within one mile for environmental and cultural features and report these to state regulatory agencies. Data on your property would become **part of a permanent public record**.

This would result in hundreds of private owners impacted (by wetlands, vernal pools, deer yards, etc.) and could **jeopardize your property rights**.

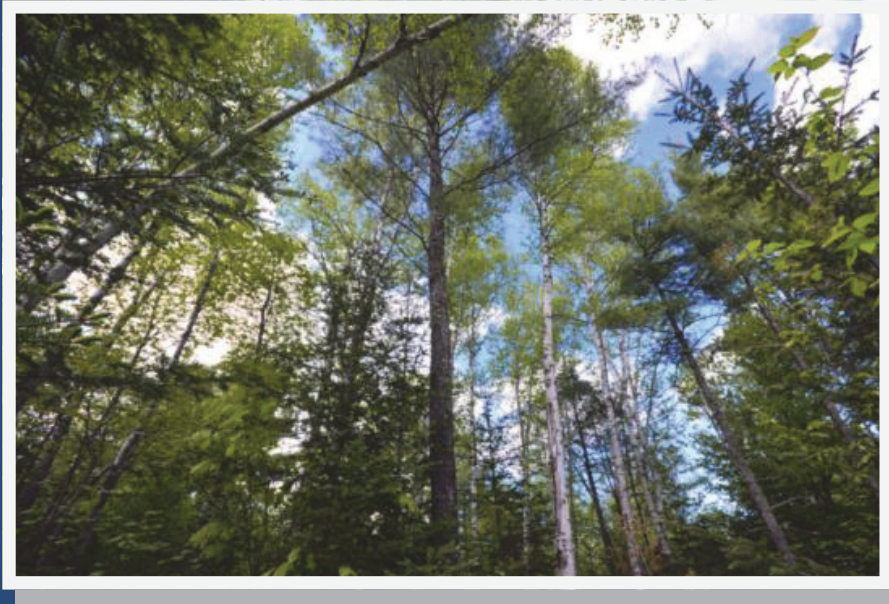
The proposed ordinance would prevent transmission lines within 1,750' of any structure. To be consistent, the town could also prevent any new development within 1,750' of existing transmission lines.

Please think about the future before you vote on this ordinance at the March 10th annual meeting. MEPCO works closely with landowners who are willing to engage to find a route that works for them, **including relocating the line if possible**, to avoid or minimize impact to their property.

Passing this sweeping ordinance is not the answer.
